

Wild Mountain Scholarship Program

Objective: To give Wild Mountain seasonal team members the opportunity to earn tax-free income for use toward their post high school education.

Eligibility: You must be at least a senior in high school.

Requirements: Complete a scholarship application each season. The application must be completed by December 1st for the winter season and July 1st for the summer season.

Commit to an ending date for each season you work, and fulfill that commitment.

With your first application, turn in an essay which includes the following: Why you work at Wild Mountain, what you have learned by working at Wild Mountain, what could be done to make Wild Mountain a better place to work, and what your plans are for the future, where you think you will be, and what you think you will be doing 10 years from now.

Maintain a clean disciplinary and attendance record.

How it works: The program year will run from October 1 through September 30. After the year-end date, all applications will be forwarded to the Scholarship Committee. Upon approval, Wild Mountain will issue a check payable to the school listed on their application. Generally, first year qualifiers will receive \$.25 for each hour they worked during their first year of the program. Depending on work performance, availability, and other valid requirements, an applicant's hourly scholarship rate could increase each year for which they qualify. This rate may be separate from any regularly paid wage, or wage increase.

When eligible, ask your supervisor for an application.
